#1 Qinghua Tea Pot Set



This 8-piece beautiful Qinghua tea set will easily help you achieve ZEN when used to appreciate tea.

#2 Jade Carving



Based on the wine vessel of the early Zhou Dynasty (1100-1000 B.C.), this beautiful and elegant wine vessel was carved out of natural jade with a unique design.

#3 Inner Painting

#4 Cloisonne Jar



Cloisonne is an ancient technique for decorating metalwork objects, in recent centuries using vitreous enamel, and in older periods also inlays of cut gemstones, glass, and other materials. The resulting objects can also be called cloisonné.

#5 Bronze Wine Vessel



Exquisitely made, it is 3-legged and loop-handled wine vessel in early Western Zhou dynasty. 22cm in height. It is unique for its beautiful shape amongst the Western Zhou bronze vessels. It is not only artistic, but also a rare treasure!

Maotai was named a national liquor in 1951, two years after the founding of the People's Republic of China. Maotai also claimed the gold medal at both the Paris International Exposition of 1985 and 1986. Maotai has won 14 international awards and 20 domestic awards since the Chinese Revolution. It is the only alcoholic beverage presented as an official gift by Chinese embassies around the world.

#23 Diaoyutai
