Dr. Paul Evans will speak about China's rise as a global power which is more than just economics. With this new status, there are changes in the global balance of power and in the international institutions and universal values that Canada has long cherished. Professor Evans will examine the implications for Canada. Issues he will address include how should we respond to global China as individual citizens and as a nation? Is engagement still the right approach?"

Dr. Evans is Director, Institute of Asian Research, University of British Columbia. Among his many distinctions: he was Visiting Scholar, Asia Center, Harvard University (1997-99); Director, University of Toronto-York University, Joint Centre for Asia Pacific Studies (1991-96); Co-chair, Canadian Member Committee of the Council for Security Cooperation in Asia Pacific (1993-97); co-chair of North Pacific Working Group, CSCAP (1994-98); Co-chair of the Asia Pacific Foundation of Canada (2005-08). Professor Evans' current writing focuses on East Asian regionalism and Canada's Asia policy; he is completing a book on Canada and global China.

Directions to Gatineau City Hall/Maison du Citoyen

25 rue Laurier, Gatineau (Hull Sector), Quebec

To access free evening parking underground, follow carefully:

From the Alexandra Bridge (Interprovincial Bridge) or the Portage Bridge, take rue Laurier.

From Laurier turn onto rue Hôtel de Ville.

After a few 100 yards, at the green/white **P** sign turn immediately right to go down the ramp for the Maison du Citoyen/City Hall parking.

If you do miss the **P** ramp for the City Hall parking and end up going underground emerging onto rue Victoria, just continue and go around the short half block back onto Laurier, then Hôtel de Ville and try again to get the correct **P** ramp for the parking.

Take either elevator up to the ground floor (rez-de-chaussée), turn left to the end to the Press Room.
